This year, 782 students continued their educational journey because of your support. That is 782 students who stayed in school, who gained access to new opportunities, and who are now preparing to contribute their skills and talents to our community. Your investment not only shapes their futures, but it also strengthens the future of our community, our state, and our region.

As you read the stories of the students featured in this year's report, know that the students highlighted in these pages represent hundreds more whose stories, successes, and transformations were made possible through your philanthropy.

Together, we also provided nearly \$1 million in program and facility support, helping Casper College advance innovation and excellence across campus. In addition, \$28,000 in emergency funds ensured students could persevere even when unexpected challenges stood in their way.

As you'll see on page 7, fiscal year 2025 was an exceptional year for investment performance, with returns totaling \$13.9 million, representing 74% of our total revenue. Because scholarship spending is based on a five-year rolling average, the impact of these earnings will extend well into the future, increasing our scholarship capacity and amplifying the foundation's long-term impact.

Thank you for choosing to partner with us, for believing in students, expanding opportunity, and helping build a stronger community. We are grateful for all you make possible.

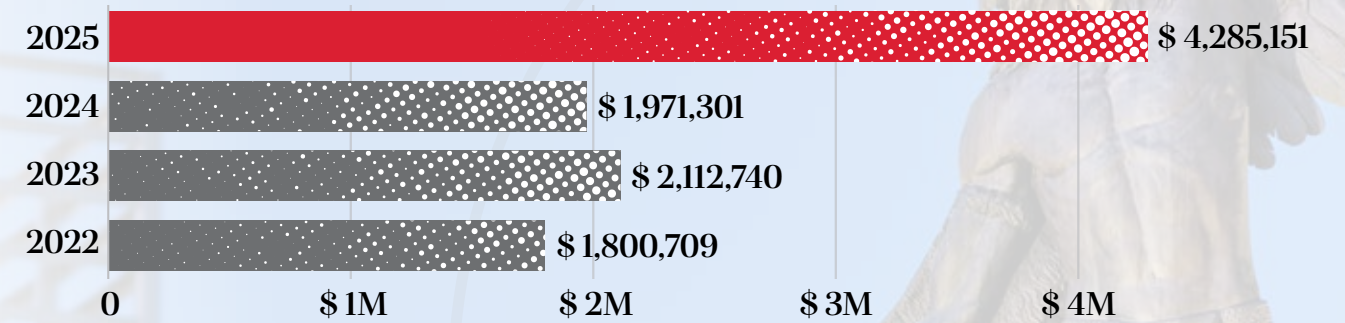

## Income • FY 2025 Sources of Income

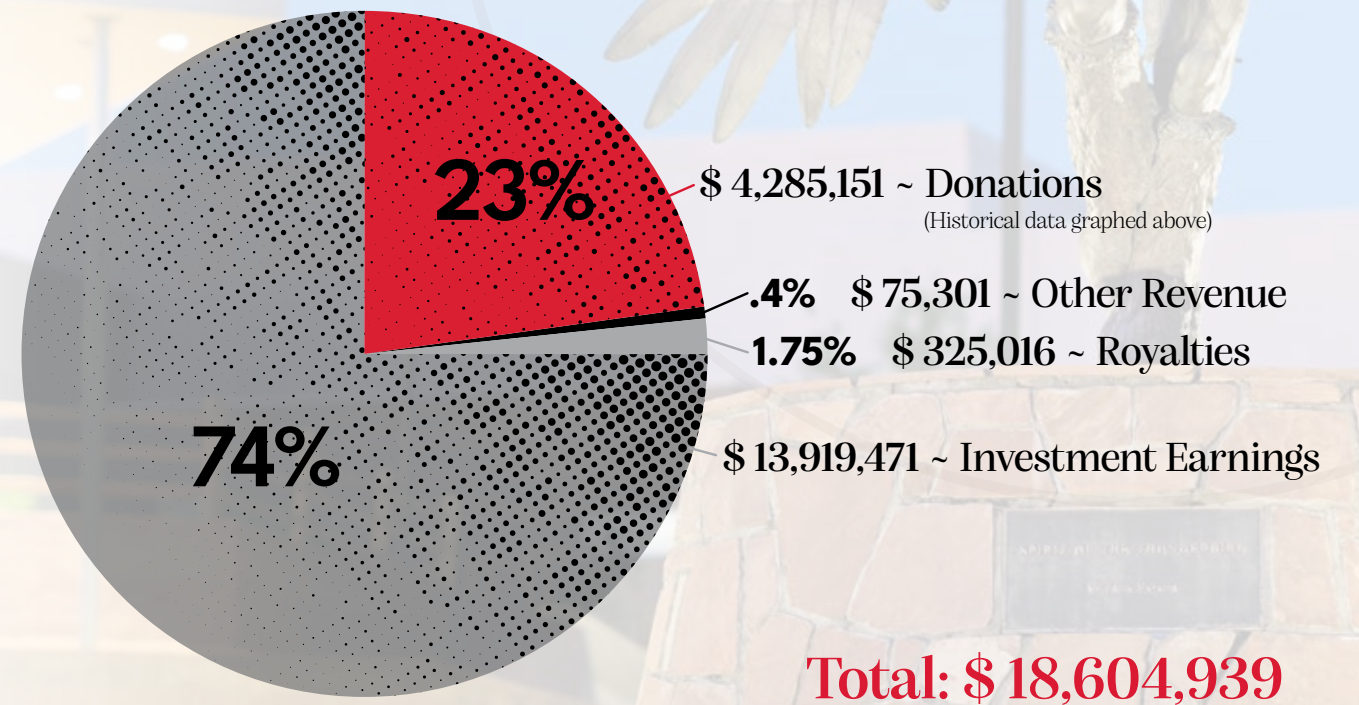

One night, in a fit of loneliness caused by a lack of direction, I applied to Casper College on a whim. I'll never forget how the support bar in my friend's couch, which had doubled as my bed for several months, dug into my back while I submitted my application. A couple of weeks later, I received an email about advising day and decided to show up, still with minimal direction. I introduced myself and stated quite candidly that I was starting at square one and had no idea what to do. Thankfully, the advisers at Casper College immediately took me seriously and bent over backward to get me on track to start school. Within a month, I was registered for classes and moved into the dorms as a participant of the STAR program.

I struggled financially while attempting to put myself through college. I don't think I had ever "adulted" in that capacity, and the transition from couch surfer to the path of scholarship was difficult. Unbeknownst to me, things were about to get significantly harder as a pandemic was about to derail all sense of normalcy I had worked for. I was 19 when lockdown began, and shortly thereafter, my best friend took his own life. These compounding struggles ultimately led me to make the difficult decision to drop out.

However, in 2023, I made the choice to try again. Now, just two weeks shy of my 25th birthday, I am proud to say that I am roughly one semester away from graduation and one significant step closer to building a future I am genuinely proud of. This achievement would have been impossible without the support of my friends, family, facilitators, but most importantly ... the donors. Your generosity has been truly life-changing, representing far more than just an educational opportunity — it has been a pathway to personal growth, healing, and renewal. Your investment in students like me doesn't just fund education; it transforms lives and creates possibilities where none existed before. Today, success and perseverance are redefined every time sweat beads on my brow or my hands tense up, knowing that each challenge overcome is a victory made possible by your belief in second chances.

Thank you for making dreams achievable for nontraditional students who refuse to give up on their futures.

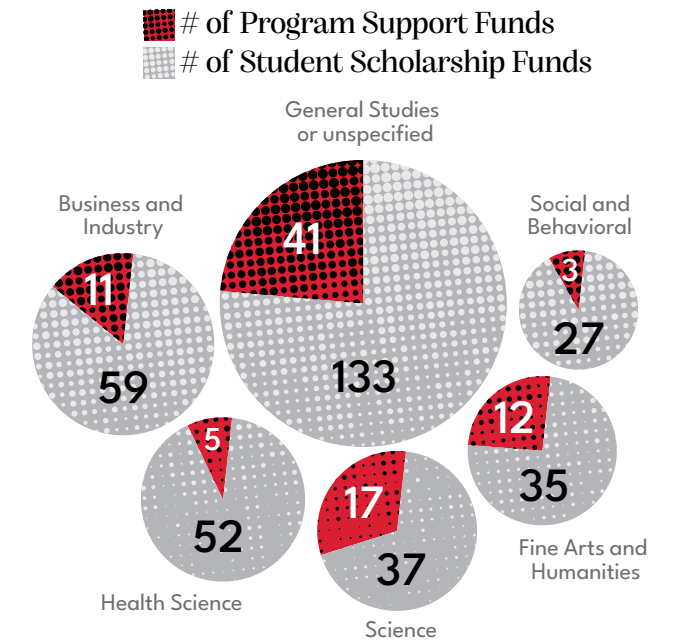
